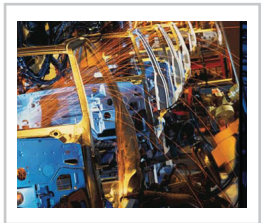
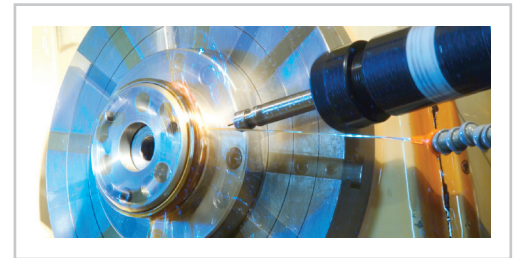
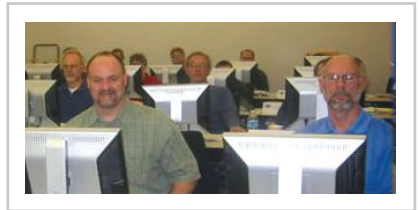
CPT assesses individuals in five critical work functions:
